
TESS MUNROPEDREROS

From cabaret to contemporary, Tess has developed shows with several North American aerial dance and theatre companies, and performed in some of Europe's biggest big tops. She has been honoured to receive several scholarships and residencies internationally, including the Emerging Aerial Choreographer award to the Frequent Flyers Aerial Dance Festival. In recent years she has developed a methodology for improvisation and has begun shared this practice with students from New Zealand all the way to the European Aerial Dance Festival.

She approaches aerial with curiosity and creativity and invites students to do the same.

She helps artists discover authentic and unique ways of moving in the air, through exploration, expression and excitement.

Lyra Labryinth

Wrap, weave and wind your way around the Lyra in a workshop full of twisting, tricky transitions. We will have fun deconstructing perplexing pathways and discovering new entrances and exits to classic moves.

Focusing on the "in-between" spaces, we will seek to enrich the moments between tricks as much as the big shapes we know and love.

The class will incorporate spinning technique and investigate how to use the spin to inform our movement. Perfect for people who want to stitch together their own fluid sequences on the hoop.

Prerequisites- Comfortable on Lyra and confident being in the air for at least two minutes.
